Seats	: 2 Seats per Guide/Mentor
Methodology	: Contact Classes, Workshops & Monthly evaluation by Guide/ Mentor

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GTI Fellowship Programme SOP:-

- a. Application Invitation for GTI fellowship programme on prescribed format.
- b. Registration fee submission (Non Refundable) followed by Topic allotment of candidate choice or choice of GTI Fellowship Core committee.
- b) Synopsis* submission within 20 Days from date of Topic Allotment.
- c) Go ahead Final Approval by GTI Fellowship Committee for research work on Topic after an Interview.
- d) After Approval, Programme Fee Submission (Registration fee will be adjusted) & Guide/Mentor will be assigned.
- e) GTI Fellowship Core Committee decision will be final.
- f) During Research proceeding any type of additional expenses incurred will be borne by Fellowship candidate like Lab Charges , blood Tests or Research subject product etc. shall be borne by applicant/researcher.
- g) After successful completion of Fellowship Programme, Fellowship will be awarded.

* Guidelines for the Preparation of synopsis

1. The following format should be followed in preparation of the final copy to be submitted. The synopsis may contain 800-1000 words excluding the references.
2. The entire document should be typed with double space between the lines, 12 pts font size and Times New Roman format. All the headings should be typed in bold letters.

Note: The document will be checked for plagiarism. The document should contain the following sections:

1. Background of the topic selected (It may include the Rationale for choosing the topic)
2. Utility of the study (Relevance in the present context)

References:

- If the contents of the dissertation are taken from any websites or books or medical journals the same should be cited at the bibliography/references section.
- References must be numbered consecutively in the order in which they are mentioned in the text in the reference / bibliography section.

The following are examples for how to write the references.

Journal article

- Joseph B, Nair PMK, Nanda A. Effects of naturopathy and yoga intervention on CD4 count of the individuals receiving antiretroviral therapy-report from a human immunodeficiency virus sanatorium, Pune. Int J Yoga 2015; 8:122-7.

Chapter in book

- Phillips SJ, Whisnant JP. Hypertension and stroke. In: Laragh JH, Brenner BM, Editors. Hypertension: path physiology, diagnosis, and management. 2nd ed. New York: Raven Press; 1995 pp. 465-78.

All guidelines mentioned above should be followed for smooth study of the synopsis.
